Eagles Schoolboys Cup (Years 8–9 Male)

The Eagles Schoolboys Cup is an interschool competition for boys in Years 8 & 9, coordinated by WA Football.

Divisions

WAALITJ Division (A Grade): Strong football schools with home & away games across the metropolitan area.

EAGLE Division (B Grade): Schools of medium strength with home & away games played locally where possible.

Competition Format

- Played during Terms 2 & 3
- Home & away games across metropolitan and regional areas
- Managed by WA Football Staff

Resources Provided

- 1 leather match ball for all nominated schools

Eagles Senior Schoolboys Cup (Years 11–12 Male)

The Eagles Senior Schoolboys Cup is a high-quality interschool competition for metropolitan and country schools throughout Western Australia. It is coordinated by WA Football and the Secondary School Football Advisory Committee (SSFAC).

Competition Format

- Played during Term 2
- Wednesday after-school matches
- 2 x 25-minute halves
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GLEN JAKOVICH Division (A Grade): Strong football schools competing across the metropolitan area.

ROSS GLENDINNING Division (B Grade): Schools of medium strength competing locally where possible.

C GRADE: Schools competing in a metropolitan home & away competition, with fixtures scheduled locally where possible.

BILL WALKER Division: For schools participating in the 'A' section at Senior High School Country Week.

1 match ball (first 50 schools to nominate). SSFAC reserves the right to adjust divisions to maintain a balanced competition

Freo Dockers Cup Lightning Carnival (Years 7–9 Female)

The Freo Dockers Cup Lightning Carnival provides schoolgirls with the opportunity to experience football in a safe and enjoyable one-day carnival format, or further develop skills gained through their Physical Education program. It is coordinated by WA Football.

Resources Provided

- 2 synthetic footballs per team
- Participation certificates and posters

Freo Dockers Cup (Years 10–12 Female)

The Freo Dockers Cup is an interschool competition for senior schoolgirls, coordinated by WA Football and the Schoolgirls Advisory Committee.

Participation in the Freo Dockers Cup provides an important pathway into community youth and senior women's football competitions.

Competition Format

- Played during Term 2
- Tuesday after-school matches
- 2 x 20-minute halves
- Two metropolitan divisions plus SHS Country Week
- Divisions may be adjusted by the Schoolgirls Advisory Committee to maintain balance
- Country competitions managed by WA Football Staff
- Divisions

MOORE Division (A Grade): Strong football schools seeking quality metropolitan competition. Top teams progress to finals.

WHITE Division (B Grade): Regional pool format with local competition before finals. Top teams progress to finals.

VANDERWEIDE Division: For schools participating at Senior High School Country Week.

- 1 match ball (first 50 schools to nominate)

Freo Dockers Schoolgirls Cup (Years 7–9 Female)

The Freo Dockers Schoolgirls Cup is an interschool competition for girls in Years 7–9, coordinated by WA Football.

Division 1: Strong football schools competing across the metropolitan area.

Division 2: Schools of medium strength competing locally where possible.
